5. If you publish a story or poem, what "pen name" would you choose?

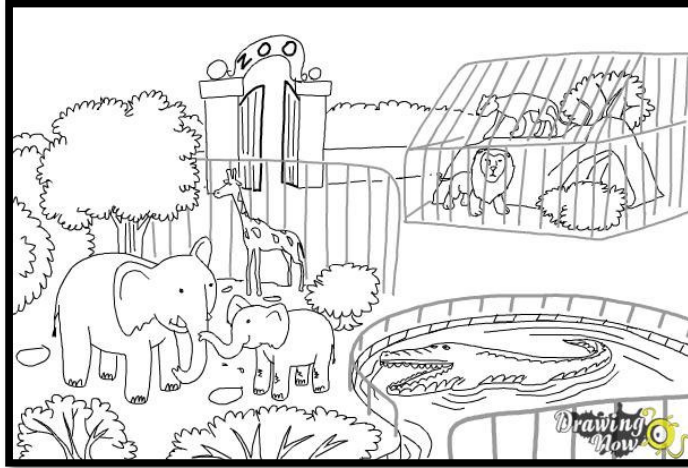
